



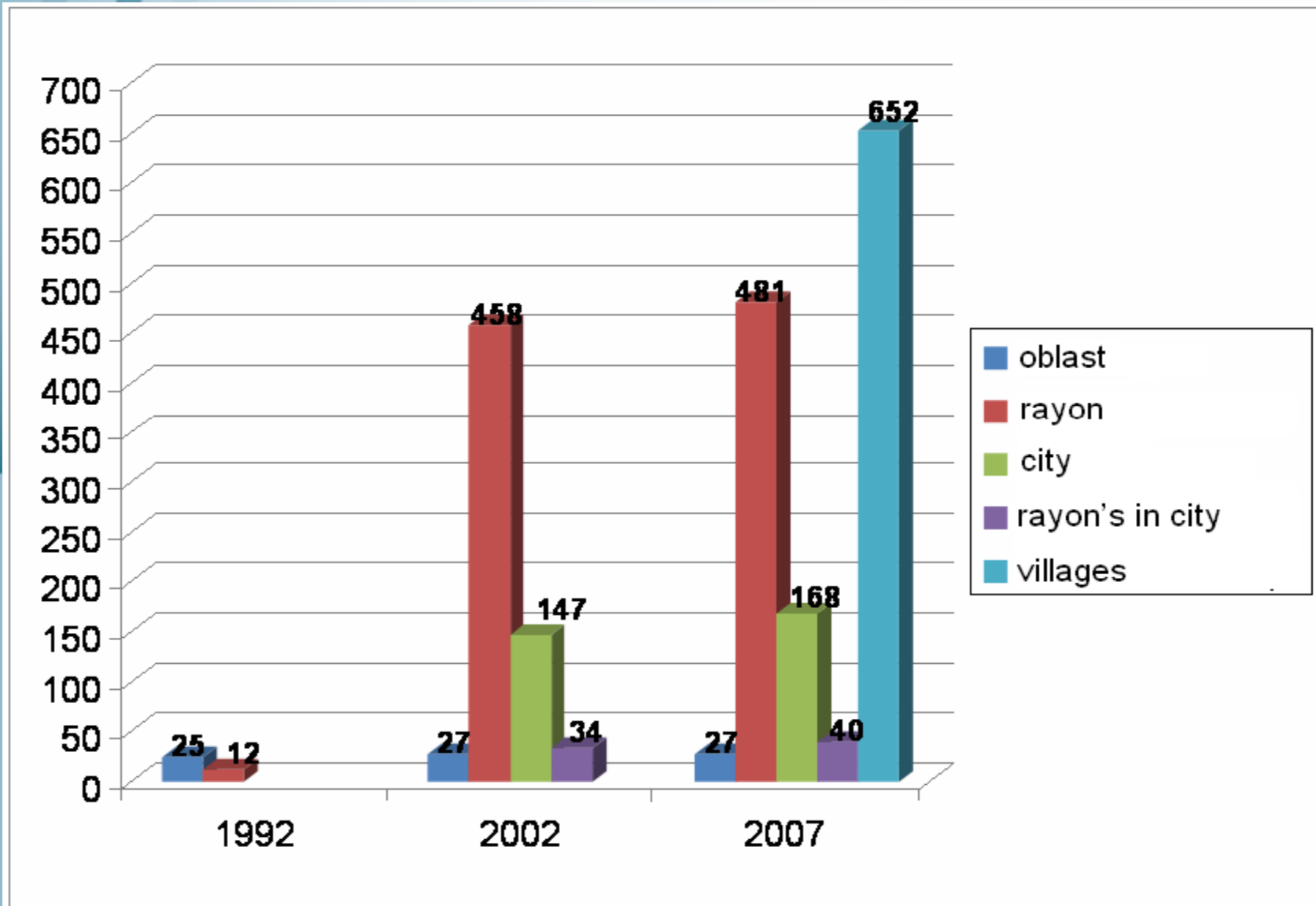

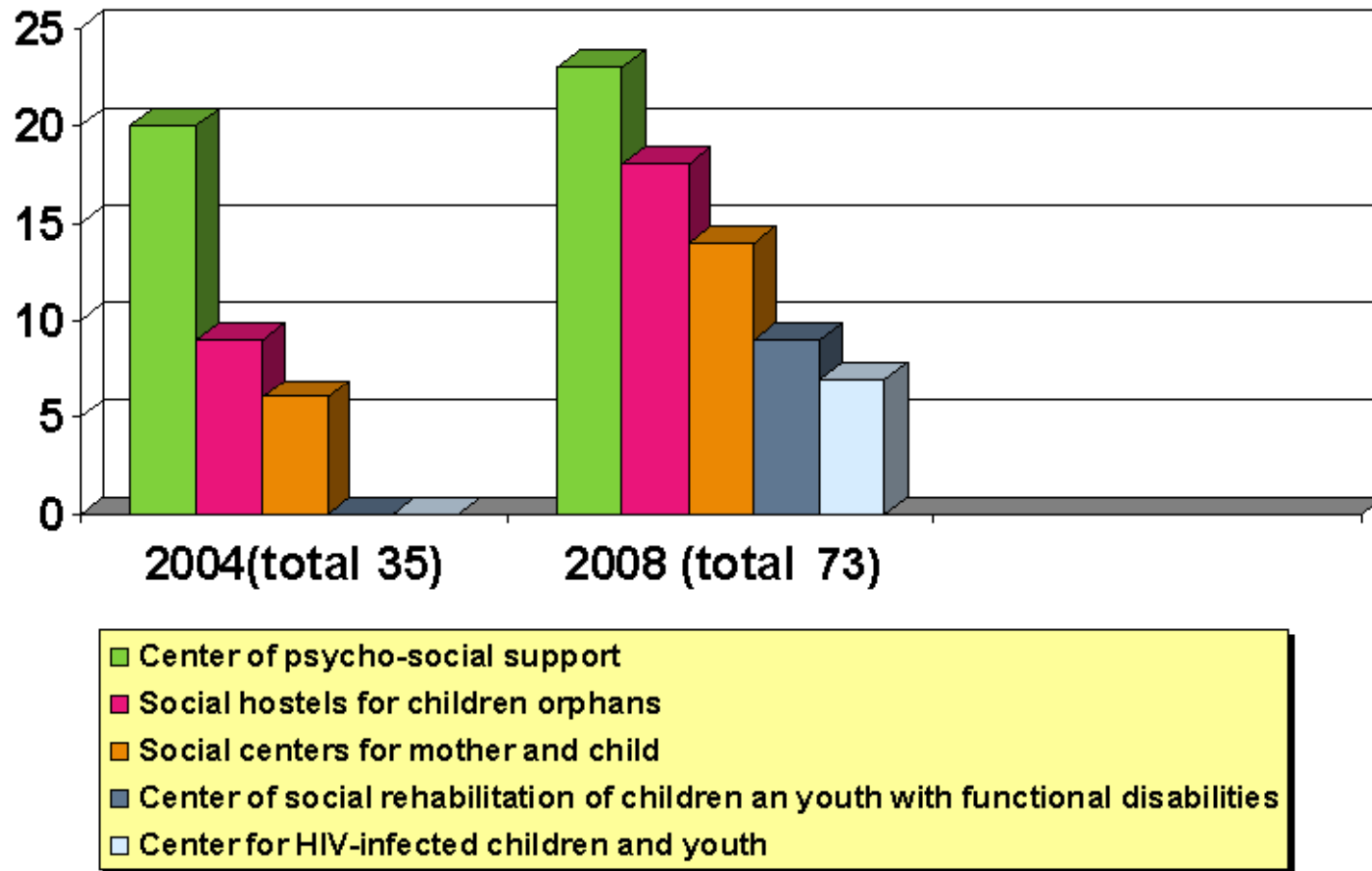

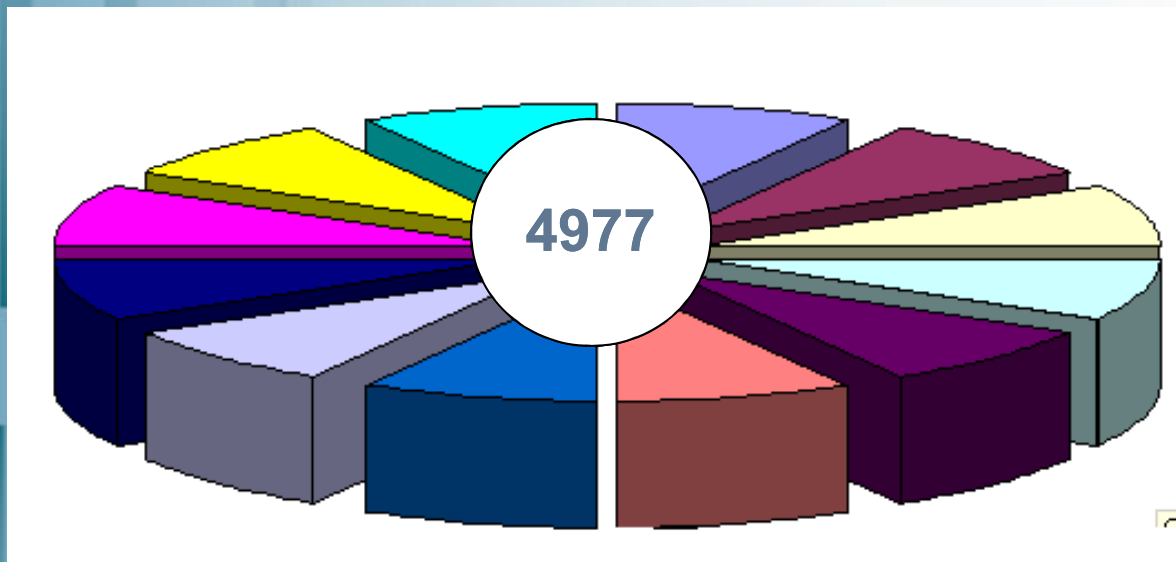


Dynamics of Development of Social Service, Psychological Support and Rehabilitation Centers



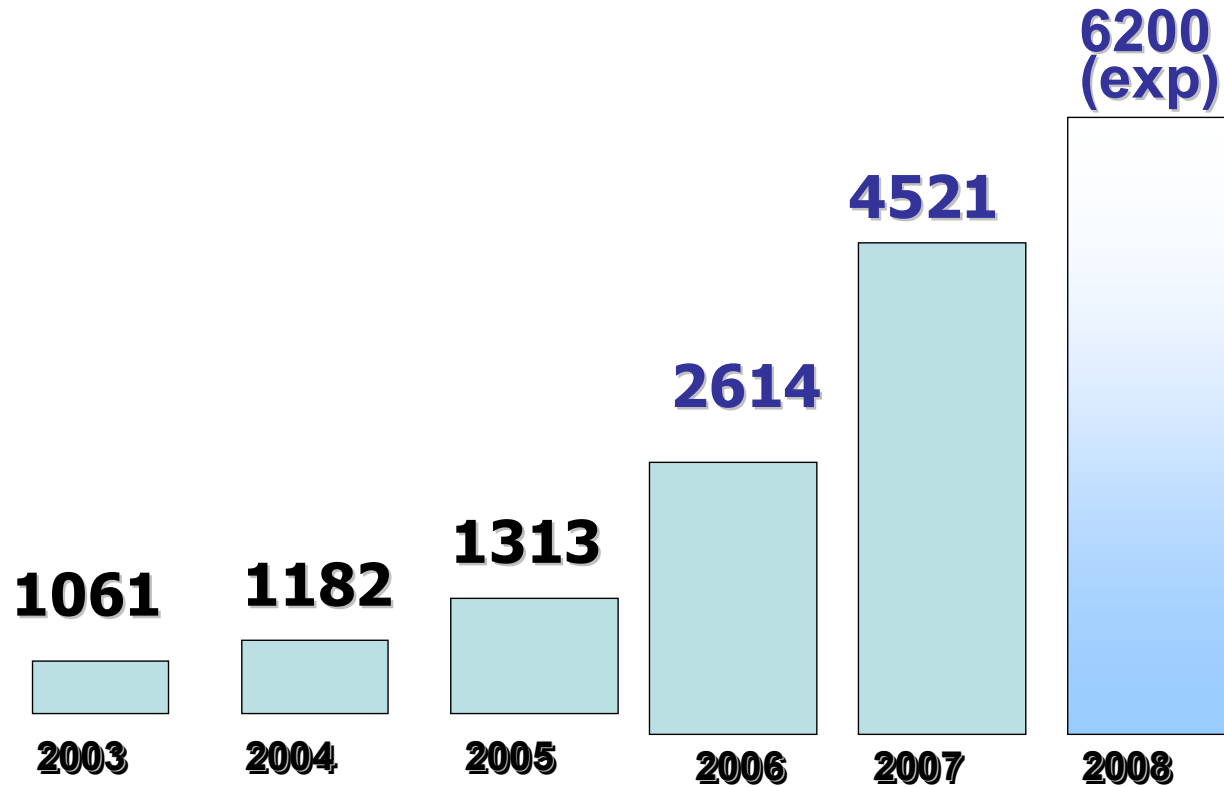
Categories of recipients of services provided by the Centers of Social Services for Family, Children and Youth

2008 – 12 categories
4977 – specialists

- Graduators and former students of internats
- Care givers, ship guards
- Foster families and family type children houses
- HIV-positive children and youth
- Families in crises
- Street and uncared children
- Women wanted to reject the child
- Addicted youth
- Adolescents with risk behavior
- Former prisoners (youth)
- IDUs

Strategy of Social Service Development for Family, Children and Youth in Ukraine (2009-2014)

Goal: Provide an access for families,
children and youth to high-quality social
services on a community level

Strategy 2009-2014: Priorities of social service development for families, children, and youth

- Make social services available in each community
- Developing, testing and implementation of minimal state social standards of quality of social services through engagement of clients and private sector
- Developing a system of monitoring and assessment of the quality and accessibility of social services
- Improving the quality of social work of state social centers through developing qualifications of social workers
- Developing the social service market through an appropriate environment and engagement of private sector for the service delivering

Challenges

- Minimize the negative impact of economical and financial crises to the poorest and most vulnerable population of Ukraine (families in crisis, children and youth invalids, orphans, drug addicts, HIV-positive persons, victims of trafficking, foster families, former prisoners, single parents, etc.)
- Guarantee the social services of respect quality and social protection for the most at risk (in need) population of Ukraine
